Thanks to everyone's participation earlier this school year, a Spring Fundraiser is not needed to meet the annual \$35,000 goal. We have exceeded the goal by \$3,625,19! The Walk-a-thon raised \$14,573.08, the

Lottery Calendar Raffle raised \$22,178.56, Box Tops is currently at \$87.90 Coke Gives is at \$28.00, and the current Dine Out proceeds are \$1,757.65 (includes Chipotle). Additionally, volunteers Mrs. Lynn Larrabee and Mrs. Linda Klein run the monthly school store. Mrs. Larrabee shops yearly for 'deals' so that our K-8 students can purchase school supplies, gifts and trinkets at very affordable prices. This store is something the students not only love, but it helps teach them math and money management skills too. In the

2023-2024 school year, the store profited \$1,061.03 for the Principal's fund, used to buy various items for students throughout the year. In the last 10 years, the school store has profited \$6,525.31! Thank you Mrs. Larrabee & Mrs. Klein!!
